

Yet, despite their contributions, Nigerians often encounter the restrictive boxes into which society frequently places them through either racial perceptions or underestimations of their professional capabilities.

This persistent challenge has given birth to the BONDS Awards, an initiative that aims to shatter these restrictive boxes and shine a light on the remarkable achievements of Nigerians in Canada. The BONDS Awards was conceived not just to celebrate, but to empower and inspire. By acknowledging the excellence within the Nigerian diaspora, we aim to elevate the narrative surrounding our community, highlighting the resilience, innovation, and success that define our people. Importantly, this celebration is not only for the broader Canadian society to witness our achievements; it is crucial for fellow Nigerians immigrants, who may feel discouraged or even consider returning home.

The BONDS Awards serve as a channel to encourage them to persist and excel in this land they have come to call home, reinforcing that their contributions are valued and their potential is limitless.

Through the BONDS Awards, we seek to affirm that Nigerians are not only capable but are leaders and trailblazers in various sectors. We strive to create a platform that not only recognizes such achievements but also motivates the entire diaspora to aspire to greater heights.



ABOUT BOND AWARDS



In December 2006, Modupe Ehinlaiye and her family embarked on a new chapter, relocating from Nigeria to Canada. Bringing with her a robust background in corporate and retail banking, and having founded a microfinance company in Lagos, Modupe was well-prepared for the challenges ahead. After earning a Business Analysis Professional certification in 2008 and an MBA from the Richard Ivey School of Business in 2011, she seamlessly transitioned into the Canadian professional landscape. By 2014, not only had Modupe established her own law practice specializing in Family Law and Estates, but she also achieved the notable accomplishment of becoming dual-qualified to practice in both Nigeria and Ontario.

However, her journey was not without obstacles. As one of the few black lawyers in her field, Modupe faced racism and witnessed the detrimental effects of negative stereotypes on the BIPOC community. These experiences shaped her legal practice focusing her advocacy on women and children. Her dedication to justice and equality led to her appointment as an Administrative Judge with the Immigration and Refugee Board of Canada's Refugee Protection

Division in 2021.

Throughout her career, Modupe observed that many accomplished Nigerians abroad struggled with low self-esteem due to persistent negative perceptions and stereotypes. This was not just a professional observation but a personal experience that resonated deeply with her own challenges. In response, Modupe founded TWM Studios Inc. and launched the Talk with Mo" show in February 2023, aiming to challenge these narratives by highlighting life-changing stories of everyday people.

Building on this momentum, the need for a more formal recognition platform became apparent. This realization led to the creation of the BOND Awards.




